Gayle Crompton moved the Board accept the lowest responsible bidder, The Lombard Company, and proceed with contract negotiations including the base bid of \$5,798,000.00 with the alternates of: Alternate 1: Portico, Alternate 2: Water Service, Alternate 4: Radiant Heat in Plaza, Alternate 5: New Fascia Panels, Alternate 6: Exterior Cast Banding, Alternate 7: Polished Concrete Floor – with testing and approval, Alternate 9a: Butt Glazing, Alternate 9b: Butt Glazing (all rooms) with the alternates totaling \$495, 400.00 and the grand total for said project totaling \$6,293,400.00.
